Hunter Karl Reynolds left us on April 15, 2019. Karl was born August 21, 2001 in Las Vegas, Nevada, to Blair Ramon and Sheila Hansen Reynolds. Karl was 17 years old and a senior at Mountain View High School in Orem, Utah. He was a member of the school's Jazz Band where his passion for drumming showed. Since the day he was born he loved music. He had a desire to learn many instruments, learning them very quickly, his love being the drums and guitar. He also enjoyed playing and composing music with his own band. He was an avid runner and ran practically every day. He loved to participate in marathons, bringing home many medals for his accomplishments. At Mountain View he participated on the cross-country team, swim team, jazz band, choir, and loved all his History and English classes. He loved reading, listening to music that wasn't main stream, hiking, biking and going to the gym.

Karl did acts of service but did it in his own quiet way, always anonymously and without other people knowing. He was a member of the Sunset Heights Third Ward of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. Previously he enjoyed activity in the Edgewood ward in Provo, Utah where he had an affection for his home teachers, priesthood leaders, and other ward members.

He had many friends who he spent time with and the Blake and Carrie Johnson family was especially important to him. Their son Jack was his inseparable best friend. They could be found enjoying life, playing video games, playing music together, and spending hours in deep conversation. They were truly brothers.

His father Blair Reynolds preceded him in death April 2015.
