January 2, 1937 - December 17, 2018

Llewellyn Young Leigh, 81, passed away peacefully at home Monday, December 17, 2018. His death marks the end of nearly 4 years battling the results of a stroke. His kindness and unending gratitude for all the help given him during this time is a testimony of his strong and gentle character. He will be missed by many family members and friends who love him dearly and have been comforted and encouraged by him through the years.

Lynn was born on January 2, 1937 in Ann Arbor, Michigan to Llewellyn and Margaret Young Leigh. He grew up in Palo Alto, California and graduated from Palo Alto High School. He played football and baseball, enjoyed the ocean and was a champion springboard diver.
