Maurine Mayberry Robinson, age 86, passed peacefully on August 9th 2014 from natural causes. Clark and Afton (Bill) Yingling. She has 13 grandchildren and 28 great grandchildren. She is preceded in death by her parents, her husband and her sister, Naomi (Blaine) Gray.
