February 23, 1977 - October 4, 2021

It is with very heavy hearts that we share the passing of Rebecca Ann Gordon Brockbank, 44. She passed away on October 4, 2021, from multiple organ failure. Rebecca had several massive heart attacks in the summer of 2020 and she fought hard to get back home with her loving husband and son. She was able to spend another year with “her boys” and her pets as she continued to fight for recovery.

Rebecca Gordon Brockbank was born February 23, 1977 in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. Rebecca along with Dennis and Sheila, her biological siblings, were adopted by Robert and Peggy Gordon in 1985. Rebecca grew up in Oklahoma and lived in Texas and Idaho for a short period of time before making her way to Utah. Her passions in life included reading, drawing, crocheting and pretty much anything artsy or crafty. In 1996 Rebecca met the love of her life, Brent Brockbank. Brent and Rebecca were married in Springville, Utah on October 19, 2002. Rebecca always wanted to be a mother. Her dream was realized in 2009 with the birth of her son, Ezekiel (Zeke). Rebecca was an amazingly dedicated mom and was Zeke’s greatest advocate as she fought to ensure that he had all the possible resources made available to him for his learning and education.

Rebecca loved spending time with “her boys”, Brent and Zeke, whether it was camping, fishing or hanging out in their backyard pool. Rebecca loved animals and always had numerous pets that she loved and cared for. Rebecca made many cherished friends both locally and online as she shared her talents and passions. Rebecca had an incredible ability to forgive those that trespassed her. She had a testimony of priesthood blessings and of the atonement of her loving Savior, Jesus Christ.

There is comfort in knowing that Rebecca is no longer in pain. Her mortal body was plagued by pain for much of her life. Despite this, sometimes, debilitating pain she lived a full and wonderful life dedicated to her husband and son.
