Robby was raised in Pleasant Grove, Utah. This is where he played in the orchards, hiked the hills, and worked in the hay fields. He attended Pleasant Grove High School. Robby was the heavy weight state champion in 1989 as well as a star football player. Robby will always be admired and looked up to for his achievements in high school as well as in everyday life. He was a sincere, loving and kind being. Robby's presence in our lives has been more inspiring than he might realize. Robby had a "larger than life" presence to many. This was in part due to his immense stature. After becoming friends with Robby everyone realized his stature wasn't the only immense part about him...Robby's love for others was also "larger than life."

Robby worked as a concrete worker for the majority of his life. Being the hard worker he was, he was the man for the job. He enjoyed work and made many friends in the industry. These relationships were strong and remain intact to this day. Robby was a proud resident of Pleasant Grove for all his life. He only temporarily left us to explore new endeavors in Parker, Az. He moved to our family's reservation where he tried his hand at being an Adult Detention Officer, Grounds Keeper, and finally Maintenance Supervisor. He worked for the Colorado River Indian Tribes.

Robby leaves behind four younger siblings and their spouses; Brandon Jones, April and Jared Sutch, Aaron and Jory Jones, and Serene and Adam Kennedy. Robby's siblings have always looked up to him and always will. They considered him their "protector". Robby was the favorite uncle to his nieces and nephews; Ethan, Tarren, Landon, Coby, Penelope, Jaxon, Gabriel, Dallas, Quinn, and Rain. He was the uncle to many children in our extended family along with friend's children that proudly called him uncle. The extended list of nieces and nephews came as no surprise, as all children that had the opportunity to meet Robby fell in love with him.
