Our beloved husband, father, grandfather, brother, uncle, and friend, Scott F. Andersen, passed away peacefully on November 23rd, 2012, at home surrounded by his loving family after a courageous battle with cancer. He was 51 years old. Scott was born on October 20, 1961 to Lynn and Mary (Paxman) Andersen in Eureka, California. He graduated from Enterprise High School and attended Southern Utah University, Colorado School of Mines, and Metropolitan State College of Denver graduating in 1995.
