



## Sheri Golledge

July 10, 1937 - November 10, 2020

Sharon “Sheri” Rae Golledge passed away peacefully, but unexpectedly, at the age of 83 of natural causes on November 10, 2020. She was born on July 10, 1937 in Salt Lake City, Utah, and was the first child of Kenneth and Alice Haslam.

Her family moved to California when she was 8 years old and she graduated from Westchester High School in the greater Los Angeles area. She married James R. Golledge in 1954 and raised their family in Northridge, California. In 1993, she and Jim moved to Menifee, California. After Jim’s passing in 2009, she lived in Murrieta, California, for five years, before finally moving to Pleasant Grove, Utah.

Sheri was a devout member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints and served in various church callings throughout her life. She was an avid sports fan and enjoyed traveling with her husband Jim.

She worked as a bookkeeper for many years, and then began working for her son for 30+ years in his tax business in Temecula, California.

She is survived by her daughter Vicki Smiley, sons Robert, and Michael, 10 grandchildren, 24 great-grandchildren, sister Linda Moody, and brother Gary Haslam. She is preceded in death by her husband Jim of 55 years, and both of her parents.

Jim served in the Marine Corps during the Korean War, and Sheri will be laid to rest by his side in the Riverside National Cemetery in Riverside, California.

A family viewing will be held on Sunday, November 15, 2020, at the Utah Valley Mortuary in Lindon, Utah, at 1:00 P.M., with the funeral service at 2:00 P.M. Due to Covid, the viewing and funeral will be private; however, the funeral service will be available for virtual viewing through Zoom.
