Irene Sue Woodbury, "Susie", passed away on February 18, 2016. Sue was born to W. Evans Woodbury, Jr. and Donna Stephenson Woodbury on February 24, 1950 in Brigham City, Utah.

Sue was a valiant and very special spirit of our Heavenly Father. She was blessed with the "spiritual gift of love" and was able to extend this gift of love to others. Family and friends were very important to Sue throughout her life and she maintained these relationships through being loyal, helpful, and generous to the people in her life. She was a member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints and was "firm" in living the gospel teachings.

Sue was born an "Rh Factor Baby" at the time when prevention and treatment of this condition was new and not readily available. This experience at birth left her with lifelong challenges of Cerebral Palsy but Sue persevered and graduated from Weber Adult High School and Weber L.D.S. Seminary. If something was hard for Sue to do she kept trying until she could do it! The list of her skills and accomplishments include learning sewing, knitting, crocheting, embroidery, piano, typing, swimming, cooking, ironing, housekeeping, and participating in 4-H club and Girl Scouts. She was a United Fund poster child in 1959.

Sue was taught by her parents to be industrious and hardworking. She worked for many years as a reliable and dedicated employee for the Weber County Library, Deseret Industries in Ogden, and Intermountain Health Care in St. George. Sue was also taught to enjoy and see the world around her. Sue traveled to England, Hawaii and the South Pacific, Canada, and many places throughout the USA.

Sue is survived by three of her siblings: Mayone Kinikini (Daniel); William "Bill" Woodbury (Mary Ann), and Stephen L. Woodbury (Colleen). She was preceded in death by her parents and her sister LoRane Miller (Jesse).
